## 3. Wiki

#### 3.1. Plugins

The following macros and plugins were added :

- <u>NoteBox</u> to create message boxes
- PageOutline to create the table of contents on each page
- <u>Toc</u> to create the table of contents between pages
- **NumberedHeadlines** to manage the numbering of the headers
- Acronyms to automatically create a glossary
- Wikinfo to display the last modification date
- Wikicss to manage a stylesheet used by all pages (wiki:Doc/wikicss?)
- <u>SectionEdit</u> to edit one section at a time
